St. John's Episcopal Church is part of the Episcopal Diocese of Texas. The Episcopal Church takes pride in being radically inclusive and speaks out for human rights. It approved the ordination of women as priests in 1976, prohibited discrimination against sexual orientation within its ranks in 1994, and elected its first openly gay bishop in 2003. At St. John's, we also value inclusiveness, and everyone is welcomed without exception. We are people from different countries, cultures, races, ethnicities, and who speak different languages. In 2021, Mother Minerva Camarena Skeith was called to be St John's rector.
